# E412 / E413 - After Hours Procedure Premiums

## The Short Version

This modifier code applies to 70% of the hours in a given week!

TIP!: note this
""night" code is an
exception and uses
a '3' (vs H12x, H112)

- Document the **TIME** of any procedure performed
- Add the modifier code to your blue sheet billing codes
  - o **E412** (+10%) Mon Fri 17:00 24:00 or day time (07:00 24:00) Sat, Sun or Holidays
  - o **E413** (+30%) Nights 7 days a week (00:00 07:00)

### **Details**

As of Sept 1, 2011, most of our <u>surgical</u> procedures (think <u>lacerations</u> and <u>ortho</u> procedures) are eligible for a premium if the procedure is performed "after hours".

These codes (**E412** and **E413**) are for the <u>procedure</u> only, and are very distinct from the after hours premiums associated with <u>procedural sedation</u> (ie E400C and E401C - see Procedural Sedation sheet).

Interpretation (Schedule of Benefits p GP80)

We can add these premium codes to most procedures :

- non elective surgical procedures (including fractures and dislocations)
- major invasive procedures ie. nerve block or central line (N/A with Gxxx codes)

#### **Documentation**

- For any procedure document the time you performed the procedure
- Add applicable E412 or E413 to blue sheet beside documented procedure code

#### Example

<u>Case:</u> Saturday 02:00 - 59 male - shoulder dislocation and pubic ramus # after fall <u>ED Care:</u> 5 hours in ED, shoulder reduction with Doc 2 sedating, observation time <u>Doc 1</u> - ER Chart, Procedure (Time 03:15), Re-assessment (Time 05:15)

<u>Doc 2</u> - ER Chart, Start/Stop times for sedation (03:10 - 03: 22), Sedation modifiers (see sheet)

<u>Blue Sheet Coding:</u> <u>**Doc 1** - H123 + D016A + E413 + H124</u>

Doc 2 - D016C + 1 time unit + E401C
