1 Time Unit = \$15.01

E400c = ↑40% E401C = ↑65%

- Two different doctors must be involved to be eligible
 - Doc 1 bills for the ED assessment and procedure
 - Doc 2 bills for the <u>sedation</u> (Doc 1, or another service)
- 2. Look up the procedural code (most are on the Procedural Sedation Codes sheet)
- 3. **Doc 1** → always codes using procedure code using suffix 'A' ie ER Code (H152) + Procedure (F032A) + After Hours *Procedure* premium if applicable (ie. E412)
- 4. **Doc 2**→ must reference specific procedure code to code properly!
 - If procedure code used by Doc 1 has a (6) behind it use same code with suffix 'C' ie F032C
 - If no (6) or procedure code listed use E003C
 - Document your **START** and **STOP** times (to calculate **Time Units***)
 - Document and Code After Hours Anesthesia premiums**
 - Document and code any **Special Units***** Note: n/a if E003C is used
- * Please document CONSULTANTS name if providing sedation for another service

* Basic Time Units (PLEASE RECORD START AND STOP TIMES)

- Start time = begins when in 1st attendance with the patient with the purpose of initiating sedation
- Stop time = time when physician is no longer needed and patient is safe to leave with RN

** After Hours Anesthesia Premiums (for sedating physician only)
