

“The LEMA group does NOT use the H SVP codes, they always use the K SVP codes as they do not have an On-Call Schedule.

So use the assessment codes below:

A003/A007/A001/A005 - remember not all patients are A003.

Assessment + K962 + K994

Subsequent patients before midnight add K995

You can see 10 patients and then revert to the H133 codes and then H123 after midnight.

If you have **not** reached the maximum before midnight, then you can carry on after midnight using SVP codes:

K996 for the 1st patient

K997 for the rest”

-the travel code K692 only applies to the first patient (unless you leave the hospital and are called back in)

-any reassessment codes on top of your A and K code would be your H134 or H124

A001-minor

A005-consult

A007-intermediate/multisystem

A003-general/comprehensive
